To ensure your product is listed and checked-in correctly to your inventory set, please follow the guidelines below for all incoming packages to Kotis warehouses.

Customer supplied product (CSP) must be approved via your Program Manager (PM) and provided an IIR#.

CSP may require longer check in times and incur additional fees. Unfortunately, shipments that don't comply with our delivery guidelines may be refused.

PROPER LABELING & DOCUMENTATION

1. BOX LABELS

Incoming packages must include the following labels. Visual examples below

- 1. Shipping Label
- Client Label: Client Name, IIR # (received from PM), and # of boxes (Printable template Page 3)

2. PACKING SLIP

Your packing slip should provide a complete list of items included in the box.

Ideal information on a packing slip includes SKU numbers, size, quantity, color, description, and weight, if possible.
